SUBJECT - Objection to cutting of any tree in and around Plot no. 31 of Uday Park.

This is in reference to letter no. DDH/ADH/SZ/2019-20/4050 dated 13/03/2020 of South Delhi Municipal corporation, Horticulture department, South zone, Green park, seeking permission to remove one tree (Putrenjiva) situated "near H no. 31, uday park, new Delhi. There are two trees here. One is around 12 feet high and the other one is a large full grown tree. An Affidavit dated 13/3/2020, was also submitted by the Deputy director of horticulture, but the copy of this affidavit, given to the UPRWA by the recent owner of the property, Vagdevi Homz LLP, does not contain all relevant details like the specific tree number for which permission is being asked for.


We have certain objections and raise the following points.

1. The two trees have been in existence for years and have not suddenly appeared there. The new owner while purchasing the plot was aware of the two trees and the architecture /layout of the building could be planned keeping the trees in mind. It clearly shows that the owner /architect had plans to seek permission to cut these trees. There is enough space for vehicles to enter and exit the building with ease and the gates can be planned accordingly.
2. The permission / affidavit does not clearly mention which tree South Delhi MCD horticulture department is seeking permission to cut.
3. The offer to plant 10 trees in lieu of this particular tree in Niti Bagh does not compensate the residents living around and is not at all logical and acceptable. Planting trees elsewhere does not substitute the benefits of this tree to the residents of uday park today. It will take several years for the trees to reach the same height as this one.






